Circles Training & Skill Building

- Group Training is provided throughout the year –call to see when the next session starts.
- One on one skill building is also available.

- Meals and gatherings happen weekly.
- Childcare and Transportation available.

Circles Mentoring

- Circles will provide mentors to assist participants on their journey towards financial stability.



How Circles Works:

Goals & Future Plans

Circles Leaders go through group training to prepare an individualized economic stability plan. Through goal setting and skill building they begin to find the confidence to bring their plans into reality.

Weekly Gatherings

Circles offers weekly gatherings where Leaders and Allies come together in a safe a supportive environment. It is a family orientated program and childcare is offered on site.

Mentoring & Community

Community mentors are trained as Allies and support Circle Leaders to achieve their goals. The Circles team offers additional supports and is also engaging the community to join the fight to alleviate poverty.
